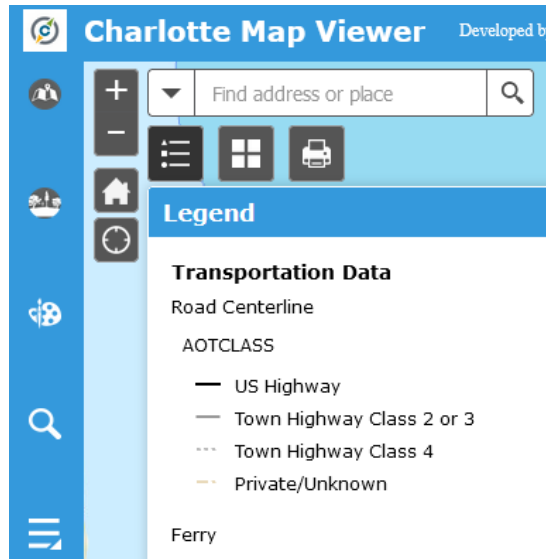


# Navigating the Charlotte Map Viewer



Legend icon – Click on this icon to see the symbology for all visible data on the map



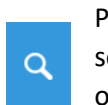
Land use and transportation icon – Click on this icon to turn data related to land use and transportation, including imagery on and off.



Natural Resources icon – Click on this icon to turn data related to natural resources on and off. Much of this data is from the Agency of Natural Resources and will be updated as the agencies updates the data.



Draw & Measure Icon– This tool will allow the user to draw points, lines, polygons, and text onto the map. Measurements can be shown on the map as well. All data drawn is added into the layer list and can be turned on/off.



Parcel Search Icon – Click on this tool to search for a parcel(s) by SPAN, Parcel ID, or Address (Address must be all uppercase for search to work).



Indicates more tools which are the Bookmark, swipe and Add Data tools.



Bookmark Icon – Zoom the map to 1:5000.



Swipe Icon – allows the user to compare imagery from 2 different years.



The Add data tool allows a user to temporarily add data to the map. This data can be a shapefile, data from AGOL, web server, a kml, or csv. See more info on next page



Use these buttons to zoom in/out on the map. The “house” icon will return the map to the full extent of town. The “circle” icon will zoom the map to your current location (even if you are not in Charlotte).



Allows user to change the base map.



This icon will allow the user to print all or a portion of the map to a pdf or image format.

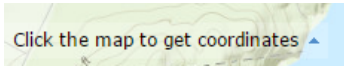
Locate an address or place. For best results include town and state.



Scale bar...adjusts as map zooms in and out.



Click on to open up attribute tables for all visible data layers. User can filter, zoom to selected, or export to .csv file (which will open in excel)







State Plane Coordinates will appear when user clicks anywhere on the map.
