

**NOTICE OF AMENDMENT TO TOWN OF CHARLOTTE  
MOTOR VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDINANCE**

The Selectboard of the Town of Charlotte does hereby ordain:

Pursuant to 23 V.S.A. §1007 and 24 V.S.A. §1976, the Motor Vehicle and Traffic Regulation Ordinance adopted September 22, 1980, and as amended on September 11, 2000, February 11, 2002, June 15, 2009, April 11, 2011, November 14, 2011, April 22, 2013, April 14, 2014, September 9, 2019, October 4, 2022, and August 12, 2024 is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1(A)(6) of said Ordinance is removed.

Section 1(C)(3) of said Ordinance is amended, and Section 1(C)(4) of said Ordinance is added, so that Section(s) 1(C)(3) and 1(C)(4) state as follows:

(C) A maximum speed of thirty-five (35) miles per hour:

3. On Route F-5 (Ferry Road) from the intersection with Greenbush Road extending in a westerly direction a distance of 0.4 miles to the railroad crossing.
4. On all unpaved Class III Town Highways except as otherwise provided in this Ordinance.
