

## ATTACHMENT A

### Scope of Work for 2025 Town Brush-hogging and Land Maintenance

---

**All work shall comply with the following specifications:**

#### **General Guidelines:**

- Contractor shall brush off equipment prior to brush-hogging each area to reduce the spread of invasive plants and seeds.
- Care shall be taken to not damage trees when trimming. Damaging trees will be grounds for terminating the contract, and not re-hiring the contractor.
- It is the responsibility of the selected Contractor to identify and stake any obstacles, potential hazards and approach routes in advance of brush-hogging.

#### **Brush-hogging Specifications:**

The following areas shall be brush-hogged twice per growing season: the first time at the end of June or early July (prior to seed formation on wild parsnip), and the second time at the end of August or early September (prior to seed formation on wild parsnip):

- Barber Hill on Greenbush Road (southwest of the Old Lantern).  
(Approximately 2.8 acres).
  - See Attachment B - Map 1
- Burns property on Greenbush Road (across from the Old Lantern):
  - Brush-hog mounds for wastewater disposal system; around and between the trees planted parallel to Greenbush Road;
  - All of the meadow to the west of the tree-line (including areas that may currently be growing brush) and within the swale that runs on a northwest/southeast diagonal through the parcel.
  - All woody vegetation and cattails are to be removed from within the swale. This material may be disposed of in the woods on the property. Also, trim within ½ foot of 25 trees along Greenbush Road in the vicinity of the Burns property (on the east side of Greenbush Road) and the Old Lantern (on the west side of Greenbush Road), and hand-cut directly adjacent to these trees.
  - See Attachment B - Map 1
- The old Town landfill located on Greenbush Road.
  - This work includes hand-trimming of the north and south slopes of the landfill cap.
  - Approximately 2.7 acres.
  - See Attachment B - Map 12
- The parcel where the old Town landfill is located at the north end of Plouffe Farm Lane—this area includes the cap of the former landfill.
  - A 75 foot “no-mow” buffer to the western property line must be maintained.
