

**Schedule of Fees for Use of the Town Beach for Group Events  
Adopted by the Selectboard on April 20, 2015**

The following fees will be charged for group events, which are separate from the beach parking fee:

For use by a Town of Charlotte resident or a not-for-profit entity for a private event:

- Events with between 25 and 50 attendees will be charged a fee of \$50.
- Events with between 51 and 100 attendees will be charged a fee of \$100.

For use by a non-resident or a for-profit entity for a private event:

- Events with 15 or fewer attendees will be charged a fee of \$10.
- Events with between 16 and 25 attendees will be charged a fee of \$20.
- Events with between 26 and 50 attendees will be charged a fee of \$100.
- Events with between 51 and 100 attendees will be charged a fee of \$150.

Events with over 100 attendees will be considered on an individual basis; additional fees may apply

All parties will be required to provide a \$100 security deposit upon request by the Town.

138 **FEE SCHEDULE FOR PRIVATE EVENTS AT THE TOWN BEACH – Action under  
139 consideration: approve**

140 There was discussion regarding a proposed fee schedule for private events at the Town Beach  
141 that was based on a fee schedule used by the Town of Shelburne.  
142

143 Mr. Krasnow suggested adding a damage clause for groups of 400 people or more, a fee of  
144 \$150 for 50-100 attendees, and a fee of \$800 to \$1000 for over 100 attendees.  
145

146 **SUGGESTIONS:**

- 147 • "Events over 100 would be reviewed upon the discretion of the Town."  
148 • Non-profit organizations would be charged \$25 for up to 99 attendees, and \$3 per car  
149 for Charlotte residents, or \$6 per car for non-Charlotte residents."  
150 • 2nd paragraph: add "...or non-profit" and strike 'non-profit' on the corporate line.  
151 • For 'corporate' change to "...use by for-profit corporation..."  
152 • Change bulleted items to read: strike the word "between" in the words "15 and 25"  
153 and "26 and 50."  
154

155 **MOTION by Mr. Tegatz, seconded by Ms. Spear, to approve proposed fee schedules for  
156 private events at the Charlotte Town Beach as recommended by the Charlotte  
157 Recreation Commission and as amended.**

158 **VOTE: 5 ayes; motion carried.**

160 **APPEAL BY DESTIGTER AND HOTALING OF FORTIN CONDITIONAL USE  
161 PERMIT (ZBA-14-09) – Action under consideration: authorize Town Attorney to enter  
162 an appearance**

163 **MOTION by Mr. Tegatz, seconded by Mr. Spell, to authorize the Town Attorney to  
164 enter an appearance on behalf of the Town of Charlotte regarding an appeal by  
165 DeStigter and Hotaling of the Fortin Conditional Use permit (ZBA-14-09).**

166 **VOTE: 5 ayes; motion carried.**  
167

168 **TOWN LINK TRAIL, CO-HOUSING SECTION – Action under consideration:  
169 approve Change Order of \$1,465 to improve drainage by adding two culverts, ditching,  
170 adding material and seeding**

171 Mr. Bloch reviewed a change order to install two culverts on the Town Link Trail of the Co-  
172 housing section for a cost of the material by Josh Ryan, contractor.  
173

174 **MOTION by Mr. Krasnow, seconded by Ms. Spear, to approve a Change Order of  
175 \$1,465 to improve drainage on the Town Link Trail, Co-housing section, by adding two  
176 culverts, ditching and adding material and seeding as per an estimate provided.**

177 **VOTE: 5 ayes; motion carried.**
